

Almost every piece of information found its way into the text. I hope that nothing submitted was overlooked or incorrectly presented. The historical notes inserted from "time to time" may provide some historical perspective to help us understand where we've been and even where we're going.

This is definitely *not* the great Canadian (or American) novel. What follows over the next number of pages is a chronological history of The Rose Family, as detailed by the submitted information. This rather ambitious effort began when Anna Mae sent out questionnaires to all the Aunts, Uncles and cousins at least 2 years ago---the information is still coming in. I volunteered to input the information, little knowing what was to come. The dates, events, personal reminiscences and anecdotes have formed quite a pile on my desk for the last 6 months or more. But as I inserted more and more items, it got increasingly fascinating. This prompted me to search out additional information. It seemed as though each fact begged another question.

THE DECADES 1861-1890

In these 3 decades: the American Civil War was fought; the Dominion of Canada was established; the Suez Canal was opened; Alexander Graham Bell constructed a telephone; Johann Strauss popularized the Viennese Waltz with *Blue Danube*; the Statue of Liberty was presented to the United States by France and seeds of the Rose Family were sown.

THE DECADE 1891-1900

In this decade: the 1st moving pictures appeared in New York; Alfred Dreyfus was falsely arrested and eventually pardoned; X-rays were developed; Marconi invented the wireless; Theodore Hertzl founded Zionism.

1897-1912

The date of birth of all the (Rose) Temnegrod siblings is not known with absolute certainty. However during these years were born: Leah, Bella, Max, Chaja, Abie, Gussie, Jennie, Simon and Joe. Jennie recounts: "--being a child where we came from, it wasn't fun. No toys to play with, no pleasures, not too much to eat, not too many clothes. None of the children in our family had their birthdays registered, so we didn't know exactly how old we were. We still don't.

In this exciting decade: Tutanekhamen was discovered; the USSR was formed; insulin was 1st given to diabetic patients; the 1st motion picture with sound, *The Jazz Singer* was released; Charles Lindbergh flew non-stop across the Atlantic; the stock market crashed and the Great Depression began---and here's what was happening in the Rose Family.

Nusie and Shaindel were detained by immigration in Halifax; upon their release, they went to live with Louie and Becky on Robert St. in TORONTO

They had a boarding house in Crystal Beach for many years--many of the boarders came back year after year for her cooking--good and

plentiful. Beryl often came to visit the family in Crystal Beach. He would put on a bathing suit and go swimming and look at the girls. Max and Annie went to night school to learn to read and write English.

Nusie and Shandel moved into their first house at 146 Grace St. in TORONTO

Yasha asked Minnie if she would marry him. She said Yes, and they got married right then. I wasn't there.

The situation in Europe was beginning to heat up: Hitler became German Chancellor; Amelia Earheart flew solo across the Atlantic; *Brother, Can You Spare a Dime*, was a hit song; the 1st concentration camps were built by the Nazis to hold Jews and ideological opponents; Jesse Owens won 4 Olympic Gold Medals in Berlin; Britain, France and Canada declared war on Germany---and in the Rose Family---

15 Cynthia *Sippy* May Rose-born-TORONTO-4th child of Becky and Louis, "----one of my first memories of life was watching my mother pack because the house we were living in (167 Robert St.) had been signed over as collateral for Pa's business, and we lost. But, undaunted, Louis Rose my Pa tried again. It was important for him to be his own boss.----I do not think anyone could ever accuse the Roses of being lazy--they worked hard and they played hard. I'm sure that is a legacy they passed down to most of us.

moved back to Toronto for good in the summer of 1938 after Marilyn was born. Joe opened a

hand laundry on Bloor St.--they lived behind the store. When the laundry was sold, Joe went to

work for Western Creamery doing residential deliveries, and served beer at the Metropole Hotel in the evenings.

OCTOBER

9

Fanny Rose passed away-TORONTO of an undiagnosed illness-age 15; from Dave and Lil; "she was a bright student who finished primary school on time in spite of being absent for many weeks. She required many transfusions and to offset the high cost (\$25) some of the brothers were blood donors. She was to start high school that fall.

DECEMBER

27

Simon Rose married Sylvia Ingber-TORONTO; Simon was working at Nusie's shop and Sylvia at Louis'. They probably got married at the Rabbi's house, returning to Nusie's shop behind the store for a family party. Lil Saiger and Dave Rose recall: "they just cleared off the cutting table, spread out the herring, nahit, black bread and beer and celebrated----it was a freilich wedding reception." Sylvia remembers that Abie and Mary lived above the shop at that time and that Mary cooked chickens for the party.

1938

Shandel and Nusie and 5 kids moved back to 797 Dundas St. West, following a strike at the shop which bankrupted the business, and lived there until 1942. Nusie started up again, this time as Dominion Girls Coats. Many family members and friends of the family worked at Nusie's over the years, among them: Beryl Rose, Jennie, Gussie, Ruben Schwartz, Charlie Starkman, Jack and Sid Ler, Sol Shafer, Simon, Harry, Abie, and Sylvia's brother Izzie Ingber

Marilyn Ruth Rose-born-TORONTO-1st child of Joe and Jean

1939

Ethel Horn recalls: "----we lived in the same house as Leah and Charlie on Montrose Ave. We (Joyce and I) grew up like brother and sisters with Morrie and Honey Starkman. In this year Bella, Hymie, Ethel and Joyce Marcus moved to Detroit, as it was hard to make a living in Toronto. There were a lot of distant cousins in Detroit and they formed a family club

Roslyn May Marilyn Rose-born-TORONTO-1st child of Sylvia and Simon

THE DECADE 1941-1950

In this decade: England sank the Battleship Bismarck; war in Europe was raging; RADAR and SONAR were developed; Japan bombed Pearl Harbour prompting the U.S. and Britain to declare war on Japan; U.S. declared war on Germany and Italy; Warsaw Ghetto erupted; German army was destroyed by Russian troops near Stalingrad; VE day; atomic bombs on Hiroshima and Nagasaki; Japan surrendered and WW2 ended; the *Diary of Anne Frank* was published; the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered; the STATE OF ISRAEL was declared; Korea-----and here's what was happening in the Rose Family

Reuben and Ida Schwartz and daughter Gert moved from Toronto to Detroit

FEBRUARY

25 Sheldon Rose-born-TORONTO-2nd child of Simon and Sylvia

JUNE

20 Jennie Rose married Boris Waxer-TORONTO; in the bright sunshine of Leah and Charlie's yard--52 Montrose Avenue.

1942

Shaindel and Nusie moved again, back to 146 Grace St. where they lived until 1943

APRIL

1 Rose (Horowitz) Silverman passed away-TORONTO-age 30

4 Anna Mae Waxer-born-TORONTO-1st child of Jennie and Boris; Anna Mae relates: our family lived with Leah and Charlie until I was 5 months old, then went to live on Markham St. with Max and Annie

MAY

14 Ruth Shirley (Heiber) Rose-born-TORONTO

30 Gail Rose-born-TORONTO-2nd child of Jean and Joe; the family now moved to 282 Crawford St, then to 371 Northcliffe Blvd.

OCTOBER

Dave Rose volunteered to join the Canadian Army

1943

JANUARY

23 Ida Horowitz married Saul Shafer-TORONTO

JULY

10 Shaindel and Nusie and family moved to 97 Chiltern Hill After several moves, Lil, as an 18 year old, declared that she would never move again. She's still living at 97 Chiltern Hill 52 years later.

1944

Anna Mae continues: "----with Nusie's help, Boris and Jennie bought the house at 4 Carling Ave. In order to pay back the loan, our house was full of tenants and Jennie returned to work. Each morning she dropped me off at a daycare centre (staffed by nuns) in a church at College and Grace. Times were tough and our parents worked hard.

3 Edward Rose married Lillian Dritz-VANCOUVER

OCTOBER

16 Marlene Rose-born-VANCOUVER-1st child of Eddie and Lil; grandchild of Louis and Becky

21 Harry Rose married Sara *Sandy* Markowitz-TORONTO-it was Harry's 24th birthday

DECEMBER

Sidney Ler entered the Canadian Army. He served his time at Camp Borden and as a guard in a P.O.W. camp in Western Canada.

24 Joel Shafer-born-TORONTO-1st child of Ida and Saul; Joel was the first recipient of a baby gift from the not-yet formed Family Club. Leah brought the gift and told Ida and Saul about the club being formed and asked them to join. Thus, Bubba Mintzes, family also became part of the Rose Family Club

1945

The 1st Rose Family Picnic was held in High Park in the summer. At the first of the regular monthly meetings that fall, Nusie became its 1st president, Mary Rose became the secretary and Molly and Dave the treasurers of the newly formed ROSE FAMILY CLUB

Leah, Charlie and Honey Starkman moved to Detroit; Mortie remained in Toronto and moved in with Jennie, Boris and Anna Mae on Carling Ave. while he went to medical school. Their living room was both his bedroom and study. He stayed until the space was needed when Stanley was born.

Murray Rose married Edith Rosen-TORONTO

SEPTEMBER or OCTOBER

Beryl (Temme) Rose passed away-TORONTO-age 82 (approx.); his dream of having his children get together regularly, so that ---"cousins shouldn't pass each other on the street and not know they're related---" had happened. Lil Saiger adds some memories: "--he would come into the shop behind the store at 797 Dundas every day, sit and sew buttons at the finishing desk. He liked to be with his family and it gave him something to do. But every day someone in the family, or friends would come in and say, "you should be ashamed of yourself making your old father work in the shop." Eventually, Nusie told his father not to come in any more--that the work was too much for him. He went home and died not 6 months later. He loved being around younger people and was no trouble around the shop. I can still see him sitting with other finishers like Jennie, his glasses over his forehead, feeling he was useful.

Abie, Mary, Sonia and May move to Detroit from Toronto

JULY

Sid Ler discharged from the Army. Nusi gave him a job in his factory where Simon taught him to be a cutter, which he did for the next 45 years.

He was the first university grad in the Rose Family and all the aunts and uncles went to his graduation at Convocation Hall. The graduation was celebrated with a party at Shaindel's house. The Rose Family Club gave Mortie a gift of a doctor's satchel, which he never replaced.

Some of the events in this decade: Elizabeth II became Queen; Sony introduced the 1st pocket-sized transistor radio; the Korean War ended; Stalin died; Edmund Hillary and Tenzing Norkay scaled Mt. Everest; Salk vaccine; Egypt seized control of the Suez Canal precipitating Israel's Sinai Campaign; ELVIS; SPUTNIK; Fidel Castro; the St. Lawrence Seaway---and here's what was happening in the Rose Family

1951

Some recollections from Joyce: "Bella and Hymie took a train from Detroit to San Francisco, fell in love with it and decided to move there. On the way back to Detroit, their train ticket included a free stop in Los Angeles. When they saw L.A. they thought it was paradise and liked

it even better than San Francisco. So we moved to L.A. instead----just by the *accident* of a free stopover

Joe opened a linen supply and laundry unit it was destroyed by fire in 1953, subsequently opening Acme Linen Supply on Howard St, which he operated until it was sold in 1956.

EPILOGUE

Even though I am only one quarter Rose, this family has had a disproportionate impact on my life. Many of my memories include skating, eating, and watching old movies at Chanukah parties, racing and eating at family picnics, eating at the odd meeting, and attending four anniversary parties.

I'm not quite sure how my keenness for our family developed, but I think my fourth grade teacher had something to do with it. That year, my teacher gave each student a single piece of paper with instructions to draw our family trees. I was in shock! How could I explain to my teacher that there was not a hope that the Rose family, never mind all four sides of my family could fit on a piece of 8.5" x 11" paper? I told her a little about my dilemma and she thought it would be interesting for me to research my Rose side. A week later, after a few conversations with Uncle Joe, Auntie Jenny, Auntie Gussie, and Cousin Sarah that resulted in inconsistent information, I handed in a 20 foot roll of shelving paper depicting the ENTIRE Rose family. At that point, my real interest in our family began.

About a month ago I found myself sitting at my dad's desk reading the memoirs that our cousins submitted for the booklet you are presently reading. I have heard many of these stories before but the pride and enthusiasm with which these stories are told is quite wonderful. Growing up I would boast to my friends about my Zaidy's fourteen brothers and sisters and my dad's paternal twenty-seven first cousins (excluding their spouses). They did not believe me for a second! As time progressed, they recognized the inordinate amount of time that I spent with this Rose Family Club. Some even asked if we were linked to the Mafia!

I am quite proud of the time and the traditions I have gained from being a part of the Rose family. Beryl's vision to have the family stay together was a noble one. There are not many people who can tell you that they know their parents' first cousins, and their own second and third cousins as well as many of us do.

I often think about the form that the Rose family club will take when my children are ready to run a race at the picnic, or light the menorah at the Chanukah party. Will there still be a party? Will there still be a club? How will my children feel about celebrating with their mother's father's family? Will the club be important to them? Will it still be important to me?

Realistically, I realize that we have our own lives and new and growing families. Perhaps we could create a "Young Rose" network so that we can be acquainted with each other's careers and families. Tonight is the perfect opportunity to meet those Rose descendants who were born in the 60's, 70's and 80's.

It would be wrong for me to expect that we would be as close or as dependent on each other as our grandparents were when they first came to this country. But...I know that there have been times when I have done exactly what my great-grandfather hoped would never happen. I recognized a cousin in a restaurant but I did not know him well enough to say hello.
